

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: In October 2012, and with assistance from consulting firms Barr Engineering and Limnotech, the city of Duluth submitted applications to the Minnesota Recovers Task Force (MRTF) and the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) for funding to stabilize stream banks and remove debris and sediment to protect city property and nearby infrastructure. This resolution authorizes acceptance of this round of funding from the Board of Water and Soil Resources (BWSR) and execution of all necessary agreements required. The purpose of this funding is to stabilize stream banks to protect infrastructure and nearby federally-funded repairs. Funds shall be payable to and from Disaster Recovery

Fund 225, Department 125 (Finance), Division 1808 Disaster Aid and Revenues),
Source 4220-06 (State of Minnesota Board of Soil and Water Resources).
