

PARK ADDRESSES

BRIGHTON BEACH ~ located on the shore of Lake Superior, 1/4 mile east of Lester River on Congdon Blvd & 63rd Ave East

CHAMBERS GROVE ~ located on the St. Louis River in Fond du Lac ~ Hwy 23 & 135th Ave W

CHESTER BOWL ~ located on Skyline Parkway at approximately 18th Ave East

ENGER PARK ~ located on Skyline Parkway at 16th Ave West near Enger Golf Course

LEIF ERIKSON PARK ~ 11th Ave East & London Rd

LESTER PARK ~ located in the far eastern section of the city at 61st Ave East & Superior St near the Lester Golf Course

LINCOLN PARK ~ 25th Ave West & 3rd St

PARK POINT ~ located at 45th St & Minnesota Ave (at the Park Point Recreation area)

ROSE GARDEN ~ 13th Ave East & London Road

INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

- A permit does not give “exclusive” use of the park; only the pavilion or gazebo; the park is still open to the public.
- We do not provide chairs, signage, or sound equipment, only the space.
- Please do not plan to arrive early unless special arrangements have been made. This is extremely important for the Rose Garden.
- “Picnic” type wedding receptions (*no live music, dancing, or alcohol*) will be allowed when combined with a ceremony at most parks, except for the Rose Garden and the new Lakewalk Park. An additional Picnic Reception fee will be added to total due, standard park fees apply.

- Staked tents are not allowed; only stand-alone 10’x20’ canopies. A \$100 deposit is required.
- Most parks are equipped with 110-volt electrical outlets – 220 are not available. Multiple items may cause an overload; please be careful.
- Water is only available in parks with permanent restrooms.
- Amplified music must have prior approval. Bouncy Gyms, moonwalks, dunk tanks, etc. are not allowed at private events. (*Requires Special Event Permit*)
- If any change to your permit requires a new permit to be issued, an additional \$25 fee will be charged.
- If a gate key is required for caterers, or to bring in supplies, a key can be issued for a \$20 deposit. Any vehicles must then be removed and the gate must remain locked during your event.
- All motorized vehicles must remain in the parking lot. Do not drive on any off-road areas such as, park pathways, grass, fields, etc.
- Please leave the area used in an orderly condition; all trash must be disposed of properly in existing containers. **Recycle!**
- The person to whom the permit was issued is held responsible for the safe conduct of all those attending the event.
- All permanent restrooms will be closed after September 30.

A permit is required for any private event at which attendance is expected to be 40 or more. If you know your group will be less than 40, you may still pay the fee to secure the pavilion/picnic area.

FOOD/COOKING

Grills are available for your use in most parks. You may bring your own, as long as coals are disposed of safely. All items for your picnic, such as food, beverages, and grills must be carried in to the pavilion unless previous arrangements for a gate key have been made.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Alcohol is prohibited in city parks unless you have secured an alcohol consumption permit. Please request this permit when making your reservation. Security may be required. All city policies and state laws will apply.

SPECIAL EVENTS

“Special” events are open to the public (races, runs, walks, festivals, or community events). They do require a different type of permit. You may contact Gail at 218.730.4306 or gwalkowiak@duluthmn.gov

SPECIFIC TO WEDDING CEREMONIES

Enger Park..... \$300 per time slot
Leif Erikson Park..... \$200 per time slot
Rose Garden Gazebo \$250 per 2-hour time slot

ROSE GARDEN GAZEBO

- you may reserve 2-hour time slots for wedding ceremonies or photos only
- chairs are allowed only for the elderly or those with disabilities
- the Rose Garden remains open to the public; you only have exclusive use of the gazebo area
- rehearsals require a separate permit

PARK AMENITIES

Brighton Beach: pavilion, fire shelter, rocky beach, grills, tables, gazebo, port-a-potties

Chambers Grove: pavilion and fireplace, grills, tables, gazebo, electric, permanent restrooms, porta-potties, fishing pier

Chester Bowl: grills, tables, electric, water, playground, informal ball and soccer field, hiking trail, public restrooms in chalet, Chester Creek

Enger Park: new gazebo, grills, tables, electric, water, Enger Tower, Japanese Garden, gardens, permanent restrooms

Leif Erikson Park: stone stage, benches, lake view, electric, porta-potties

Lester Park: pavilion, grills, tables, electric, informal ball field, new playground, hiking trail, porta-potties, Amity Creek/Lester River

Lincoln Park: pavilion, grills, tables, ball field, playground, hiking trail, porta-potties, Miller Creek

Park Point: two pavilions, grills, tables, electric, playground, volleyball courts, informal soccer and ball field, hiking trails, boat launch, beach house, permanent restrooms and porta-potties

Rose Garden: beautiful gazebo, gardens, vintage fountain, benches, lake view, electricity, permanent restrooms
