**ORDINANCE NO. 10288**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING POLICE CHIEF TO EXECUTE FITNESS FACILITY USE AGREEMENTS WITH ST. LOUIS COUNTY SHERIFF'S EMPLOYEES.**

The city of Duluth does ordain:

Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 32 of the Duluth City Charter, the chief of police is hereby authorized to enter into fitness center use agreements in substantially the form of that on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. 14-0324-12 with employees of the St. Louis County sheriff's department to allow said employees to use the city's fitness facilities located in the Public Safety Building and to deposit all amounts paid therefore into Fund 110-160-1610-4644 (general fund, police department, administration and investigation, miscellaneous fees, sales and services).

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its passage and publication.
