


Where we are doing well:


- ▶ The Police Department has NO time-lost injuries this year. That is a first for the department. Great job!!!




Total Number of Claims by Department 2013-2014



Total Claim Costs by Department 2013-2014




City of Duluth Loss Run Top 5 Departments (Based on Total Incurred)

Compared with the Nation's Average Local Government PD, and Compared to Our Own Track Record

- ▶ PDs around the nation have a 6.24% rate of OSHA time-lost injuries. Duluth PD has 0% this year.
- ▶ If the Duluth PD were average, we would expect 7 time-lost injuries amongst patrol officers alone.
- ▶ Median days away from work due to injury for a local government PD is 8. Duluth PD has had lower rates than this for 5 of the 6 previous years (2009–2014).
- ▶ In 2014, costs per PD injury claim have decreased by approximately 42% over the previous year, suggesting an overall decrease in injury severity.
- ▶ The PD has saved nearly \$50,000 in employee injury costs in 2014 when compared to the previous year.
- ▶ OSHA recordable injury rates for the PD are down by almost 30% over last year at this time (November 5th).
