AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 27-18 OF THE DULUTH CITY CODE, 1959, AS AMENDED, RELATED TO LICENSE PERIODS FOR MOBILE FOOD CARTS AND VEHICLES.

CITY PROPOSAL:

The city of Duluth does ordain:

Section 1. That Section 27-18 of the Duluth City Code, 1959, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 27-18. Same--fees.


License applications under this Article shall be submitted to the city clerk with the designated license fee, said fee shall be set by city council resolution in accordance with Section 31-6(a) of this Code. Said fee is in lieu of the peddler license fee required pursuant to Section 27-8. ~~Licenses shall be issued for a period of 12 months.~~ All licenses under this Article shall expire on the 31st day of December each year. Licenses approved in 2014 will not expire until the end of the day of December 31, 2015. Licenses are non-transferable.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its passage and publication.


