


Preliminary Budget

\$18 million will come from the ½ and ½ tax and the City of Duluth anticipates leveraging an equal or greater amount from other sources.





Trails

- **Cross City Trail**
2015: I-35 to Zoo
2016: Zoo to Knowlton Creek
2017: Knowlton Creek to Spirit Mt. and Grand Avenue (pending funding)
- **West DWP (Spirit-to-Becks) Multi-Use Trail**
2016: Construction (pending funding)
- **Grand Avenue Nordic Center**
2016: Construction of 3 km lighted trail with snowmaking (pending funding)
- **Superior Hiking Trail Improvements**
2016: Loops constructed: Bardon Peak, Ely's Peak, Brewer Park, Enger Tower, Spirit Mountain
