

SPRINT TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROJECT UPDATE

June 22, 2015

The restoration of the access roads and direct surrounding area of the Sprint Telecommunications mono pine tower has been completed with new trees, bushes and grass seeding in addition to erosion control measures. The tower is fitted with artificial branches to blend in with the trees. The public should expect some regular vehicle traffic in this project area as Miller Creek landscaping will provide maintenance for the new plantings into next year.



Reseeded access road – public should refrain from walking on the netting to avoid damage and tripping over clips that hold the netting in place. The restoration materials are biodegradable.
