



The City of Duluth, Duluth Airport Authority (DAA), Duluth Entertainment Convention Center (DECC) and Housing Redevelopment Authority (HRA) are part of a self-insured pool through a Joint Powers Enterprise (JPE) Trust Agreement. An outcome of this agreement is a renewed wellness program for all employees and retiree health plan members. Our program name is “Bridge to Wellness.”

The Bridge to Wellness committee is hosting a health fair this fall and would like to invite you to participate in the event. The health fair will be held on **Thursday , November 5, 2015 at the DECC in the Edmund Fitzgerald Exhibit Hall from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.**

Approximately 1,900 members will be invited to this event and last year well over 700 attended. The goals are to promote wellness, teach self-awareness practices through interactive experiences, and encourage participants to assume responsibility for personal health choices in a fun, supportive environment. The theme of this year’s health fair is **“Healthier Today... Happier Tomorrow!”**. We will provide biometric health screenings and flu shots and our hope is to partner with local vendors and provide a variety of informational booths to create awareness of the many wellness-related programs and services in our surrounding community.

We wish to invite you to participate in the health fair, and introduce your service and/or product to our health plan members. You will not be charged a fee for a booth at this event; however, we’ll be conducting several raffles and would appreciate a donation of value to include in the raffle. Giveaways are also welcome and encouraged! You may wish to consult with your tax advisor to determine if your donation and giveaways qualify as a tax deduction. If you decide to participate, *you will be provided the following at no cost to you*:

A basic booth (8X10’ space-blue/silver side and back drape) which will include electricity, an 8’ skirted blue table, 2 chairs and internet services(if needed,) and FREE Parking!
