## **Community Development Block Grant**

CDBG funds support community development projects including affordable housing, public services, public facilities, and economic development.

## **HOME Investment Partnerships**

HOME funds support programs that create affordable housing for low-income households.

## **Emergency Solutions Grant**

ESG funds support projects that offer basic needs and housing stabilization services to community members experiencing or at risk of experiencing homelessness.

Local organizations apply to the Community Development Program requesting these funds for their projects. The Community Development (CD) Committee reviews applications and makes funding recommendations to the City Council. Information collected during the Needs Assessment helps the CD Committee determine which types of programs are most needed by the community.
