On Wednesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Duluth Police were called to a reported burglary that occurred overnight at Great Harvest Bread in the Plaza Shopping Center, #3 South 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue East. After the business had closed on September 4th, the suspect entered the premises, rummaged through the office and stole money.

Security video provided images of the male suspect inside the business. Evidence processing of the scene revealed a fingerprint that was identified as belonging to Willie Yancey Cannon, age 51, of Duluth. Cannon has a criminal record that includes convictions for burglary, theft, and check forgery. He was released from prison in November 2011 for burglaries that occurred in 2009.

On Monday, September 10th, 2012, Willie Cannon was arrested without incident near the intersection of 1st Street and 1st Avenue East. He was transported to the Saint Louis County Jail and has been formally charged with 3rd Degree Burglary, which has a maximum sentence of five years and/or a \$10,000 fine.
