

On Saturday, January 11th, 2014 at 6:39 Duluth Police were called to the 60th Avenue West and Bristol Street for a male and a female suspect prowling vehicles.

Officers arrived and located the two suspects who had stolen items on them and in backpacks. They were identified as Alexandria Bianca Bushell, 18 years old and Daniel Edward Leskey, 20 years old. Both are Duluth residents. Both admitted to prowling at least 12 vehicles in the area as well as entering a nearby garage to steal items from a vehicle inside.

They were transported to the Saint Louis County Jail and lodged. Alexandria Bushell has been formally charged for Aid and Abet 3 rd Degree Burglary (Felony), Aid and Abet Felony Theft, Aid and Abet Theft of a Controlled Substance (Felony), Possession of a Controlled Substance (Felony) and Giving a False Name to a Peace Officer (Gross Misdemeanor). Daniel Leskey has been formally charged with Aid and Abet 3rd Degree Burglary (Felony), Aid and Abet Felony Theft, Aid and Abet Theft of a Controlled Substance (Felony).
