On Thursday, April 10th, 2014 at 1:52 PM Duluth Police were called to the 300 block of North 21st Avenue West on a shots fired incident. It was reported that 3-5 shots were fired.

Initial investigation revealed that an occupied residence and an unoccupied truck parked in front had each been hit with two rounds. No one was injured. A short time later officers located the suspect vehicle unoccupied in downtown Duluth. The suspect was described as a black male. This was not a random act.

Investigators are following up on several leads. This is an active investigation. No further information is available at this time. Anyone with information about this incident is asked to call 911 or use the DPD Tip411 system
