On Monday, May 26th, 2014 at 9:47 PM Duluth Police were called to 2nd Avenue East & 3rd Street on the report of a male suspect that was trying car doors and had just entered a vehicle. Officers arriving in the area found a male matching the suspect's description at 2nd Avenue East & 2nd Street.

The suspect was identified as Robert Louis Richey, a 44 year old male resident of Duluth. Officers located a stolen cellphone and bag on Richey.
