RESOLUTIONS FOR APPROVAL

NEW BUSINESS

1. **RESOLUTION 13D-33: RESOLUTION APPROVING A PARKING LOT** LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN BARR ENGINEERING AND INTERSTATE PARKING COMPANY OF MINNESOTA LLC RELATED TO THE STEAM PLANT AND IRVIN LOTS AND CONDITIONALLY AGREEING TO HONOR ITS **TERMS THROUGH MARCH 31, 2024**

Staff: Eng explained that Barr Engineering is expanding and relocating to a new site in Canal Park and they want parking for their employees. It is a ten year lease between Barr and Interstate Parking, to allow Barr employees exclusive use of the Irvin and Steam Plant lots from 6 AM to 6 PM Monday through Friday; after 4 PM or on weekends, any empty spots may be purchased by the public. The agreement DEDA currently has with Interstate Parking is a five year agreement, so if they are no longer the parking manager for these lots after five years, DEDA will become manager of these lots or assign it to a new manager.

2. RESOLUTION 13D-34: RESOLUTION AMENDING AND APPROVING THE 2013 DEDA BUDGETS

Staff: Eng and Scharnberg went over the changes since the last budget update.

Discussion: Many items in the budget were discussed among the group.

Vote to Approve Resolution 13D-34: Passed Unanimously Heino/McShane (6-0)

3. RESOLUTION 13D-35: RESOLUTION APPROVING CHANGES TO THE POLICIES OF THE WEST DULUTH STOREFRONT LOAN PROGRAM

Staff: Eng explained that they are making a few changes to the policies to make the program more attractive, accessible and flexible to businesses. It will allow a bigger percentage of assistance to businesses with the help of partners, including the Entrepreneur Fund, assisting with funding.

Discussion: Larson asked about marketing and end date for the money to be spent. Eng said marketing will begin this week if passed, and they hope to have \$250,000 used in the next year. McShane recommended that DEDA go to the banks to make sure they have a clear idea of this program because business owners will possibly go right to the bank instead of directly to DEDA.

Vote to Approve Resolution 13D-35: Passed Unanimously Heino/Larson (6-0)

4. RESOLUTION 13D-36: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTAMINATION INVESTIGATION AND RESPONSE ACTION PLAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,500 TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RELATING TO CITY PROPERTY LOCATED AT 40TH AVENUE EAST AND JAY STREET AND COMMITTING A LOCAL MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,500

Staff: Timm-Bijold said that this site was used to house a City gas holder tank many years ago. Staff decided to apply for a contamination clean-up grant to clean up the site for a possible future housing project. The clean-up process would need to be done for many possible future use scenarios, whether it is housing or another use.

5. RESOLUTION 13D-37: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT WITH BLUESTONE COMMONS, LLC. RELATED TO THE BLUESTONE COMMONS PROJECT

Staff: Christensen explained that this amendment allows the developer to make changes regarding the phases of the project within and between its sister corporations.

6. RESOLUTION 13D-38: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF DULUTH TO DISPOSE OF SNOW ON DEDA LOT D

Staff: Timm-Bijold said that a letter from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency Voluntary Investigation and Cleanup program was received by DEDA stating that snow storage on Lot D would be allowed with certain restrictions. It is a three year agreement, but there is a 10-day cancellation notice option if DEDA wants to terminate the agreement early.
